Let's talk about the Teen Center! Our Teen Center is for all teenagers, from age 12 (and seventh grade) until the summer after they graduate high school. We are DoD certified, and have associations with Boys and Girls Clubs of America and 4-H. We also have Anchored4Life (A4L). We have many "out of school" activities and field trips, with little or no cost for the teens.

Another program we have to help our new teens adjust is Student2Student (S2S). This program has old students show the Naples life to the new students. This will help create a positive social and academic setting on our base. Lastly, I want to talk about our amazing Military Family Life Counselors (MFLCs). We currently have nine MFLCs working on our base. The MFLCs are a wonderful way to get any kind of help you may need. Whether it is just to talk or if it is for something serious, you can always find them at school or in our Teen Center. With a signed parent permission form, you are qualify for confidential talks, ranging from help adjusting, to sad to leave, they are always there to talk. They also have group sessions! You can find their contact information at FFSC, in the school, in the Teen Center or on social media.

As a homeschooler, you have a few options. Here, you can read each one, and decide if any feel right for you.

#### **Joint**

Some students opt to take some classes in person while taking others at home. This schedule requires you to be in the Naples Middle High School building for those classes. You must be checked in and seated in your class seat before the bell rings, so you will need to arrive 5 or more minutes early for your specified classes.

#### Online

A second option is DVS. This is our DoDEA Virtual School (DVS). This option does not require you to be physically present, but you may be if you want to, as these classes will be built into your daily schedule, giving you a class period to work on them. They are not time specific, meaning you don't need to do your work at a certain time of the day, and it can be done from anywhere.

# Remote

The final option is remote schooling. This is for the people who want to use their own online program, system or curriculum. You have no ties with the DoDEA school system here, and are not required to give proof that you are in school.




We have many things for our teens to do on base.
