- Look for school specific academic scholarships (on the school website) that are applied to both in state and out-of-state/nonresident tuition costs.
- Look at state lottery-funded programs that reward high school graduates who demonstrate high academic achievement and enroll in that state's post-secondary institutions.
- Look at college fee waiver programs for veteran dependents.
- Look at states with Education Benefits for Military & Veteran Dependents
- Look at states with Education Benefits for Disabled Veteran Dependents

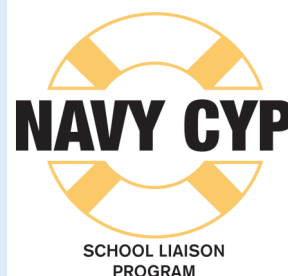

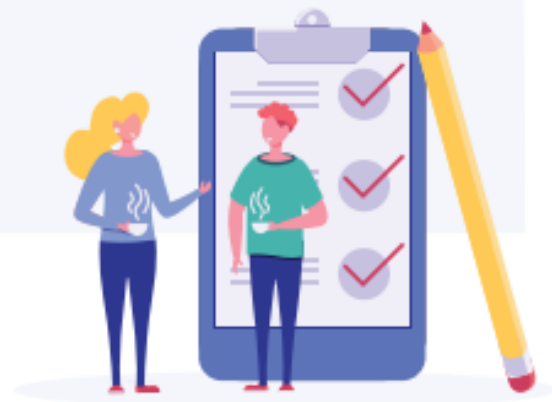
