What is a Youth Sponsorship Council?

The Youth Sponsorship Program consists of three major components:

Outreach: Identifying incoming youth and providing them with information and opportunities before they arrive.

Newcomer Orientation: Providing information and materials on programs and services available on the installation and in the surrounding community.

Peer to Peer: Connecting youth currently attached to the installation with incoming youth.

The Youth Sponsorship Council advises on specific topics. Youth can join on the third Thursday monthly from 3:30-4:30 p.m. at the Teen Center.


