Post-9/11 GI Bill® Benefits

- If you are considering transferring your GI Bill benefits to a dependent, or you are a dependent who has received transferred benefits, these five points will help you better understand how to use them:
- The transferer of benefits must have completed 10 years of service before the recipient can begin to use benefits.
- The recipient of transferred benefits may use them while the transferer still serves on active duty or after separation.
- The recipient may not use these benefits until they have a high school diploma or equivalent certificate AND have reached age 18.
- The recipient can receive housing even if the transferer(s) is (are) serving on active duty.
- The recipient must use these benefits before they turn 26 years of age.


