Important School Traffic Safety Reminder!

Please note the following timings for traffic around the school area. From 7:30 to 8:30 a.m. and 2:00 to 3:00 p.m. (Wednesdays 1:00-1:45 p.m.), Constellation Ave will have chains blocking the center crosswalk (aligned with the main school entrance sidewalk), the entrance/exit of Navy Lodge apartments, and behind apartment building 2056.

For the safety of our school-age children, we kindly request that school-age children walking or biking to school use the guarded crosswalk from the Navy Lodge to CDC, or the center crosswalk marked with cones. Parents dropping off students must use the school curb side, making a U-turn after the first island (using the fire lane), ensuring children only exit the vehicle at the curb side. NO PARKING is allowed on the right side curbs of Constellation Ave during bus drop off/pick up hours.

The CDC parking area is exclusively for CDC patrons, while school-age parents may park in the teacher/visitor fenced parking behind the elementary school for escorting their children to school.

Let's work together to keep our children safe and traffic running smoothly. Thank you for your cooperation!

REMINDER! Keep your student lunch balances with the NEX up-to-date.

How can you do this?

First, you can check the balance at 1) the lunch line cashier, 2) your LINQ account, 3) at the NEX Customer Service Desk or 4) with the School Liaison.

Second, you can add money to the account at either 1) the LINQ account or 2) at the NEX Customer Service Desk.

Third, you have an option to make reoccurring and automatic payments on your LINQ account. You may choose different amounts to charge to your credit card each time your balance hits a certain amount. You may also choose different payments and different balances for different students in the same household.

- Obtain 10-digit DoDEA Student ID# from school registrar
- You will need each student's ID# for Step 3

2. REGISTER YOUR FAMILY ON LINQ CONNECT (OPTIONAL)

- Make online payments for each student's meal
- Remotely monitor student accounts and set parental
- Set up automatic recurring payments
- Submit an online application for free or reduced meals

3. OPTIONS FOR DEPOSITING MONEY INTO YOUR STUDENT'S ACCOUNT

- Make deposits at your local NEX Customer Service
- Add money to your student's account online (\$2.60 bank convenience fee each time. To save on processing fees, make one payment and transfer funds from one student account to another.)

4. START HERE TO SUBMIT YOUR SY24-25 APPLICATION

- Apply at https://linqconnect.com (DoDEA--Navy Exchange, Alexandria, VA)
- Follow Tip Sheet for items to include and exclude (see Tip Sheet at www.navymwrnaples.com/child-
- A new application is required for each school year and each move
